Add audio description soundtracks to any video content	Add a language attribute to pages with content that isn't in the default language

Prevent resized text from requiring users to scroll horizontally	11. Consistent identification
	Label and name elements with the same function consistently
5. Text images	Use identical alt text for elements with the same function
Eliminate any images that use images of text to convey	
content	12. Error suggestion
6. Finding pages	Enable elements, like forms, to identify input errors
Add an HTML sitemap	Communicate errors to users with text suggestions

7. Headings and labels	Make changes to user-controlled data reversible
Make headings and subheadings straightforward and descriptive	Allow users to correct errors
