

WCAG 2.0 Checklist: Level AAA Website Accessibility

1. Sign language

- Upload alternative video versions with sign language

2. Extended audio description

- Create extended audio description soundtracks

3. Media alternative

- Write a full-text transcript

4. Live audio-only

- Use closed captions

5. Contrast

- Use a dark background and light text or vice versa

6. Low or zero background audio

- Eliminate background noise from audio

7. Visual presentation

- Use tools that allow users to customize background and foreground colors

8. No timing

- Allow time limits for real-time events only

9. Interruptions

- Remove redirects that happen after a specific amount of time

10. Re-authenticating

- Save users' data when re-authenticating their identity

11. Location

- Use breadcrumb navigation
- Add a sitemap

12. Section headings

- Add relevant headings to content

13. Unusual words

- Avoid idioms and jargon

14. Abbreviations

- Eliminate abbreviations or explain them in content

15. Reading level

- Use a readability testing tool

16. Pronunciation

- Link to pronunciation guides for words
