BEFORE

Classrooms were small, provisional structures made of wood & metal sheeting. Often, rooms would reach upwards of 100 degrees on a sunny day. In addition, shoddy flooring made the school highly susceptible to flooding during the rainy season.

AFIER

Students now have access to a comfortable 2-classroom school that provides a learning-conducive environment. Five new bathrooms were also added, in addition to several sanitizing stations. With our donation, classrooms are now well-lit and provide proper protection from the elements.

BEFORE

Classes were held in rooms made of wooden poles holding corrugated tin roofs, or simply outside under the shade of trees. The classrooms often became unusable when it rained, and the sound of the rain echoing off of the tin roofs made it difficult for students to stay focused. Additionally, students often had to sit on the ground during class due to a lack of desks and chairs.
